The seeds of Gennesaret Free Clinic's (GFC) dental program were planted in 1988 when Dr. James Trippi, GFC's founder, was speaking at a local church. In the audience was Dr. John Stone, DDS—Dr. Trippi's words struck a chord with Dr. Stone and he was determined to get involved. By 1989, Dr. Stone opened three dental clinics in each of the family shelters—the Care Center, DaySpring Center & Holy Family Shelter. Dr. Stone along with eighteen volunteer dentists operated these clinics for many years providing countless people with access to dental care. In April 2002, Gennesaret Free Clinic opened a new dental clinic in the lower level of the Blue Triangle Residence Hall.



Today, this dental clinic has thousands of patient visits each year providing the following services:

- Dental Health Education
- Emergency Examinations
- Cleanings
- Fillings
- Extractions
- X-rays

The dental clinic is open Tuesday through Friday, 8:00 am to 4:30 pm. **Appointments are required.** Emergency appointments are available daily, as our schedule allows. Patients are asked to call for an appointment.

The Wellness Center is an outgrowth of Gennesaret's shelter based clinics and offers a broader range of services and diagnostic capabilities. The services provided at the Wellness Center include the following:

- Health education and prevention
- Management of diabetes, hypertension, asthma and general infections
- Focus on men and women's health issues
- Basic laboratory services
- Basic medications
- Wishard Advantage provider

The wellness center is open Tuesday from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm and Wednesday and Friday from 8:00 am to 12:00 pm. **Appointments are required.**
