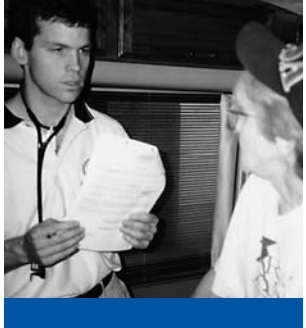

Gennesaret Free Clinic Services

- **Dental Clinic:** Blue Triangle Residence Hall
- **Medical Clinics:** Care Center, WINGS, Holy Family Shelter, Lighthouse Mission, St. Vincent DePaul Choice Food Pantry, Salvation Army Adult Rehabilitation
- **Medical Van Sites:** Cathedral Kitchen, Veterans Park
- **Medicines and Medical Supplies:** Prescription and over-the-counter medications and medical supplies given to persons visiting clinic sites
- **Health Recovery Program:** Provides after hospital care and supportive services for up to 8 homeless men
- **Shelter Health Fair:** Annual event provides health and screening services at 15 shelter sites. Hats, gloves, scarves and mittens are also distributed
- **Vision Care Program:** Free eye exams and glasses to individuals referred by Gennesaret physicians
- **Women's Health Initiative:** A social worker educates women about the importance of annual exams, schedules appointments, and provides follow-up case management
